More PB's were recorded at the Cambridge Park Run series over 5k by Martin Courtney, Hannah Shiell, Lisa Redman, Andrea Fletcher and Melanie Kirkpatrick.

Stephen Pettit (having a quiet month by his standards) was 1st MV45 and 9th overall in the Southend Half Marathon in a time of 1.17.14. Stephen could be on for another half marathon PB of 1.14.51dependant on the course distance at Wombourne near Wolverhampton being verified as correct.

Cornwall was a favourite location in June for Ely Runners with John Crisp taking time out from indulging in junk food and alcohol to finish 5th in the Lifeboat 6m race in Bude.

Finally the 12 Ely Runners who took part in the ever popular and ever demanding North Downs 30k all ran well. Kieren Drane finished in 14th with a time of 2.14.40, with John Crisp (2.15.45), Steve Tovey (2.25.17), Stephen Howard (2.27.18) and Adam Etches (2.34.00) not far behind.
