Report from John Turner on Steam Hauled Excursion

With the gift from the club towards a steam loco hauled excursion, John Turner took his wife and one of his sons, who lives locally, on an interesting and nostalgic midsummer's day circuit around his

old home area of Kent and East Sussex. John writes:

'The train started and terminated from London Victoria and was hauled by the former Southern Railway 'Battle of Britain' class light pacific 34067 '*Tangmere*' an engine built in 1947, about two years after I was born. This speedy loco (which has visited Ely) is capable of running in excess of 100 mph, but now (like all main line steam) is limited to 75 mph, particularly because of the age of the rolling stock used for steam excursions.

However, the scenic 150 miles circular route, with many stiff gradients and reverse curves, had speed limits for all trains, so the loco was sometimes used up the maximum permitted speeds. After threading through the London suburbs, the train went though the superb Kentish 'Garden of England' countryside to Maidstone and then on through Ashford International along the lonely single line across the back of Romney Marsh to Rye, Winchelsea and Hastings where it turned north to tackle the hilly and twisty route to Tunbridge Wells and join the main line at Tonbridge.

Then up the long climbs of the North Downs though Sevenoaks and Polehill tunnels and thence to Orpington, Bromley and back to Victoria. An unusual and testing route for the engine crew who, as far as they were allowed, maintained excellent time.

Although I had my head out of the window much of the time, watching my old haunts speed past, we found the standard of the catering staff on the very comfortable train was excellent and I would recommend such trips to anyone, even if they were not particularly interested in steam railways.²
