England Athletics Registration

To take part in **UKA National** and **SEAA championships**, members need to be registered with England Athletics (EA). Also, a few open events still require EA registration to claim affiliated entry fees. However, most events (especially locally) either have **ARC** permits or, if they have UKA permits, require only membership of an EA affiliated club, like Ely Runners. This year (2009-10) 35 members requested **registration with EA**. Association of Running Clubs (ARC) - Update

Ely Runners was the first club to affiliate to ARC and the Grunty Fen Half Marathon was the first race to receive an ARC permit. Since then, ARC has been steadily growing and is now generally accepted by the running fraternity as an alternative club affiliation and excellent race permit option. The ARC website http://www.runningclubs.org.uk/table.htm (which Rod Baron keeps up to date) now reports that ARC issued 243 race permits in 2009 (1in 8 races) and 162 clubs (13,342 members) are currently affiliated. It is still organised and run entirely by volunteers. Additionally, by its low cost and efficient race permits, ARC has forced UKA to hugely reduce the amount of money they were taking from clubs for races with UKA permits.

The senior team maintained its position of 12^{th} out of 17 teams in the senior league after the 5^{th} race in Bourne Woods in February, having finished last of 17 teams on the day. The junior team finished 9^{th} out of 13 teams on the day, enabling them to remain in 9^{th} position overall.

It is a busy time of year with many members training It would be great if there was to be a stronger turnout for this last race so that we finish in a position that is a truer reflection of the strength of our club . More ladies would be especially welcome, as the senior team was penalised in the last race for only having 2 female scoring members rather than the necessary 3.

Cambridge Parkrun

The inaugural **Cambridge Parkrun**, organised by **Heidi Fochtmann** and colleagues, was held on Saturday 30th January in **Milton Country Park**. Despite an unexpected fall of snow making travelling tricky on Saturday morning, there was an excellent turnout of 71 runners.

The parkrun is a free, timed 5k run held on a weekly basis every Saturday at 9am. It is open to all runners, regardless of ability.

To take part, first register with <u>parkrun</u>, then print out your unique barcode, which must be brought to each event for registration and timing purposes. All registrations for events must be made by 6pm the Friday before.

Refreshments are available after the run from the cafe in Milton Country Park.

RESULTS ROUND-UP

There have again been many excellent performances from Ely runners in a variety of events.

Six members took part in the National XC Championships at Parliament Hills in London. In the Senior Men's race were Ian Day (262nd), Robert Campbell (372nd), John Turner (772nd), Stuart Baumber (791st) and Lionel Smith (DNF - twisted ankle).

In the Women's U17 was Alice Campbell (117th).

The very demanding course was not made any easier by the very muddy conditions.

John Manlow continued his current run of good form with a 6th place (2nd Male Vet 40) at the Wellingborough 15k series.

The Campbell family of Ely Runners enjoyed a successful day in the company of Guildford Orienteers in deepest Sussex. The forest is characterised by

steep contours and is a working plantation i.e. lots of 'brashings' on the floor (O speak for chopped down branches etc). The recent rain and snow also left a very soggy forest, with all water-courses full and flowing! Robert won the M40 title, defeating the 2009 M40 British Champion (an Alan Velecky), running the 8.6k course (with 285 metres of climb) in 64.22. He finished 4th overall on the longest 'Brown' course. Alice was 2nd in W18 (and 10th overall) in 54.23 on the 4.9k (135m climb) on the 'Short Blue' and Dylan was also M12 Champion for his 5th place and 31.01 run on the 2.6k (50m climb) 'Orange' course.

On a cold and damp day the Stamford St. Valentines 30k produced a number of excellent results with new club records in three categories and seven PBs. Official Results (Chip Times): 11th Ian Day 01:53:26 (PB, New Club MV40 Record), 13th Stephen Pettit 01:54:19 (PB, New Club MV45 Record), 49th John Crisp 02:04:33 (PB), 94th Stephen Howard 02:12:01, 111th Graham Chapman 02:14:01 (PB, New Club MV50 Record), 216th Felicity Chivers 02:23:36 (PB, 1st 30k, Tied Club SF Record), 293rd David Mould 02:29:21 (PB), 406th Nick Dowdy 02:39:42 (PB), 417th Martin Courtney 02:41:16 (PB, 1st 30k), 419th Nicola Bramley 02:41:20, 473rd John Crawford 02:50:33. There were 633 finishers.

In the Midland Counties Cross-Country Championships at Stafford Common on Saturday 30th January 2009, former 2nd claim Ely Runner Claire Hallissey (nee Willer) was a close 2nd (of 145) in a tight finish with only 7 seconds separating the first 3 runners. Claire now runs for Bristol & West AC and represented England in the World Half Marathon Championships in Birmingham last year.
