We sadly report that on Thursday 17th February 2011, former member Diana Gipp, wife of ex-Chairman Peter and mother to Hannah, died peacefully at the Arthur Rank Hospice, Cambridge after a long fight against cancer. Following her diagnosis in 2009, Peter and Diana enjoyed as much time together as possible, including several walking holidays in the Lake District and Devon. Resolute as ever, for most of this period, Diana continued her work with STRADA stroke patients and to exercise at the Paradise Centre.

Diana was an extraordinary and determined athlete whose long Sunday runs were as legendary as were her numerous race achievements. In 2001 she ran the Seven Sisters/Beachy Head Marathon in an impressive 4:00 and then, whilst an FV44-46, she was *outright* Cambs Road Race League women's champion for

three successive years between 2000 and 2002. Diana was also first woman in three Frostbite League races from 2003 to 2004 and still holds eleven club veteran records with age-grading of 78-83% including 3:12 for the 2004 London Marathon.

Our thoughts and sympathy go to Peter and Hannah as they cherish the life of Diana.

The last Frostbite races of the 2010/2011 series returns to Hinchingbroke Park on March 6th. As usual, the juniors start at 10:15 am and the main race is at 11.00am. The junior team are currently 6th out of 13 teams and the senior team are currently 8th out of 17 teams. In order to improve our position in the league an excellent turnout from club members is essential. Scoring is based on the finish position of each team's first 3 women and 7 men (first 1 girl and 4 boys), but all runners influence the team's overall result. All runners of all abilities are strongly encouraged to take part.

The scenic course at Hinchingbrooke Park consists of grass, dirt tracks, woodland paths and some tarmac sections. Trail shoes would be ideal if you have them, though road shoes will be adequate. Frostbite Friendly League 2010-2011

Remaining FFL dates and venues are:

 6 Mar Hinchingbroke Park

This series of six races of 1.5m for Juniors and about 5-6m for Seniors is free to all members and provides enjoyable competition at all levels, plus all members running influence the result by competing against scoring members of other teams. No prior entry or numbers are required as club members are allocated PIN numbers and finishing position tags which are recorded by the club's Team Manager Eric Drury. Team scoring is Juniors 1st 5 (1 must be a girl) and Seniors 1st 10 (3 must be women) but all other runners effect the overall result.

Having won the Senior FFL twice since 2004, we slipped last season to 10th of 17 teams. Our talented Juniors, in their first full year in the FFL improved through the season to finish 9th of 13 teams

but should gain places in 2010-11 because there are more members to ensure a full scoring teams for each race. Apart from providing enjoyable team and individual competition, these races provide a measure of progress and inspiration throughout the winter season.
