The last of the 8 **Cambridge Road Race League (CRRL)** events was incorporated into the Fenland 10m at West Walton near Wisbech on Sunday 31st October. The overall CRRL results have not yet been received but will be notified to members when known.

The second race of the **Frostbite Friendly League** is on cycleways and roads at Bushfield, Peterborough on Sunday 21st November - meet Paradise at 0900.
