ELY RUNNERS - RACES & EVENTS 2004-05

The last of the 8 **Cambridge Road Race League (CRRL)** events is incorporated into the Fenland 10m at West Walton near Wisbech on Sunday 31st October. Club standings will be calculated from the best 7 results of 8 races and individuals from the best 5 of 8 possible scores. Awards will be made to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd m/f teams and m/f individuals. After the Grunty Fen Half Marathon (in which several members were unable to run due to helping with the event), the club's men are 3rd of 22 teams (with 190 points, only 4 behind 2nd place NVH) and women 5th of 17 teams. The club's men's positions include Maurice Reed 9th, Alan Rutterford 11th, John Turner 17th, Stephen Howard 29th, and Max D'Ayala 46th. The women's positions include Karen Foreman 19th, Birgitta Bramley 43rd, and Fran Crawford 57th. A good turnout in the Fenland 10m will make up for the several members who were unable to run in the Grunty Fen. *With a strong club entry in this last of the league events, Ely Runners' men may be able to overtake NVH to finish 2nd in the league and the women improve on both their team and individual positions.*

If any club vets would like to make up a team/teams for the **BMAF Cross Country Championships** at Earlham Park in Norwich on Saturday 16th October, they should contact John Turner (01353 667678) ASAP as entries close on 5th October. Age groups (stages) are men 40+ (4), 50+ (4), 60+ (3) and women 35+ (3), 45+ (3) and 55+ (3). Each stage covers 3.5k of rolling parkland. Entry fees will be paid by the club.

The first race of **Frostbite Friendly League** is at St Neot's (new venue) on Sunday 10th October. The club won the league by the skin of its teeth last season but, with two more clubs (Nene Valley Harriers and Stamford Striders) in the league, competition will be fierce. It is therefore important that we have a good turnout for the first race to open our account in a strong position. There are 6 races (see below) in the series of 5-6 miles over a variety of terrains. All races start at 11:00 am and a full scoring team is 10 members of which at least 2 must be women. Details of each event will be circulated by Team Captain Torsten Lytken and will appear on the club notice board. The club's Team Manager/Recorder will be Eric Drury (mob 07876 288496). The league membership fee for the 2004/05 season is £100 and will be paid by the club so all members will run free of charge. Club colours must be worn whilst competing in the league. In cold conditions, vests can be worn over the top of T-shirts. The Senior Presentation Evening will be at the BRJ Club, Huntingdon on Friday 25th March.

The list below includes **Ryston Runners Cross Country Grand Prix at Shouldham Warren** near Downham Market with 6 Sunday race dates from October to March with distances of 5k, 6.5k and 9k twice in the series. There are also shorter races for -7, -11, -13, -15 and -17 age groups. The courses are on undulating forest tracks and ideal for beginners or more experienced runners. The **Beachy Head Marathon** is on Saturday 23 October starting at 9:00 am at Eastbourne. Members who have entered (10) are advised to ensure they are fit for this demanding (26m mainly off-road with 3,500 ft of climb) event and to incorporate some long hilly off-road runs into their training. The last 7-8 miles across the Seven Sisters cliffs and Beachy Head are particularly hard. Due to injury, Kevin Collins is unable to run and anyone who would like to be officially substituted (FOC) for Kevin should contact John Turner (tel 01353 667678, mob 07718882917, email john <u>tiurner@jtsd.co.uk</u>) ASAP. Runners and supporters meet at the Paradise at 05:30 am to arrive in Eastbourne at about 8:00 am. Conditions are usually mild but often windy and occasionally wet. Therefore it is best to wear or carry a technical fabric long sleeved T-shirt. The running surface varies from chalky/stony/flinty muddy tracks to smooth downland sheep grazed turf. Trail shoes or adequate road shoes are suitable.

Other members running in autumn marathons will be John Crawford (**Loch Ness** - 3rd October), Adam Etches (**Snowdonia** - 31st October), and Keith Mitchell (**New York** - 7th November). John Crawford and Keith Mitchell will be running a marathon for the first time.
